



Mt. Pleasant Public Schools Board of Education: 5/4/26 & 5/18/26

- Approved GIRESD actual 2024/25 budget and proposed 2026/27 budget.
- Approved Ratification of tentative MPEA agreement (7/1/26-6/30/28) which outlines working conditions but not wages,
- Approved 2026-27 Food Service renewal with a 1% increase
- Approved the ratification of: MP Transportation Association letter of agreement & memo of understanding with MPEA (teachers), MPSPA (support personnel), MPCEA (community education) MPAA (administrators).

Isabella County Board of Commissioners: 5/5/26 & 5/19/26

- Approved and authorized Chairperson to sign the Inmate Medical Program proposed contract with Sweet Water Medical and Mental Health and Psychiatric Services. Sheriff's Department also plans to add an additional nurse. These changes as well as discussions with rep from Blue Cross Blue Shield will result in a cost savings of \$120,000.
- Approved the contract with BS & A Software to transition from previous software which will not be supported after 2030. Transitioning will increase subscription costs, but county will see improved security, better operational flexibility, continuity of operations and will lock in cost right now.
- Approved a contract with NetSource One for \$229,359.48 for Central Dispatch Server and Network Infrastructure Refresh. This will provide upgrades that will improve system dependability and maintain uninterrupted emergency communications.
- Approved the FY 2027 Isabella County Community Corrections Plan Application for \$149,129.50. Annual plans must be aligned with the state's goal of reducing prison commitments by emphasizing rehabilitative services.
- Approved an agreement that allowed the County to accept Crestwood Holdings donation of 6.61 acres of land adjacent to the Commission on Aging property. This will allow for the potential expansion of COA programs and services.

Mt Pleasant Planning Commission: 5/7/26

- Reviewed 2027-2032 Capital Improvement Plan and recommended that the City Commission approve it.
- Discussed the possible rezoning of the southwest corner of Crawford and Broomfield Roads and the dissolution of the existing Planned Residential Development (PRD) Agreement. Approval was given to begin the legal process to dissolve the PRD Agreement. City Commission has final authority on all rezonings.

Mt. Pleasant City Commission: 5/11/26 & 5/26/26

- Approved an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance that increases the maximum permissible fence or wall height from six feet to eight feet in Industrial Districts, provided they are not located at street frontage or adjacent to civic spaces.
- Approved amended agreement with PACT (non-union employees). Policy changes agreed to include the development of a six-week paid parental leave policy, frontloading time-off for new employees and elimination of service credit purchase for pension.
- Discussed how to handle \$130,000 opioid settlement and types of restrictions if chickens are allowed in backyards. City Attorney has been asked to draft a proposed ordinance regarding backyard chickens for future City Commission review
- NOTE: Tuesday, July 21 at 4 pm is the deadline to submit a nominating petition for one of the four City Commission seats on the Nov 3, 2026 ballot.

Union Township Board of Trustees: 5/13/26

- Approved \$28,500 for Engineering services for pump station #10; total project will be bid in fall for est. cost of \$205,000
- Approved rezoning request for 7.7 acres north of River Rd. at Morey Drive to agricultural
- Approved an agreement for EDA support for improvements at Jameson Park. A 2% grant has also been requested.
- Treasurer Lori Rogers commented that Charter Townships are only required to meet once a month and suggested that Union Township consider making this change in the future. Discussion followed with no final decision.
